## Socially Yours

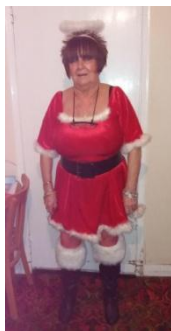
Socially Yours Friendship Group has returned after the Christmas break. Everyone is welcome and we would love to see you there. Open to all abilities.
